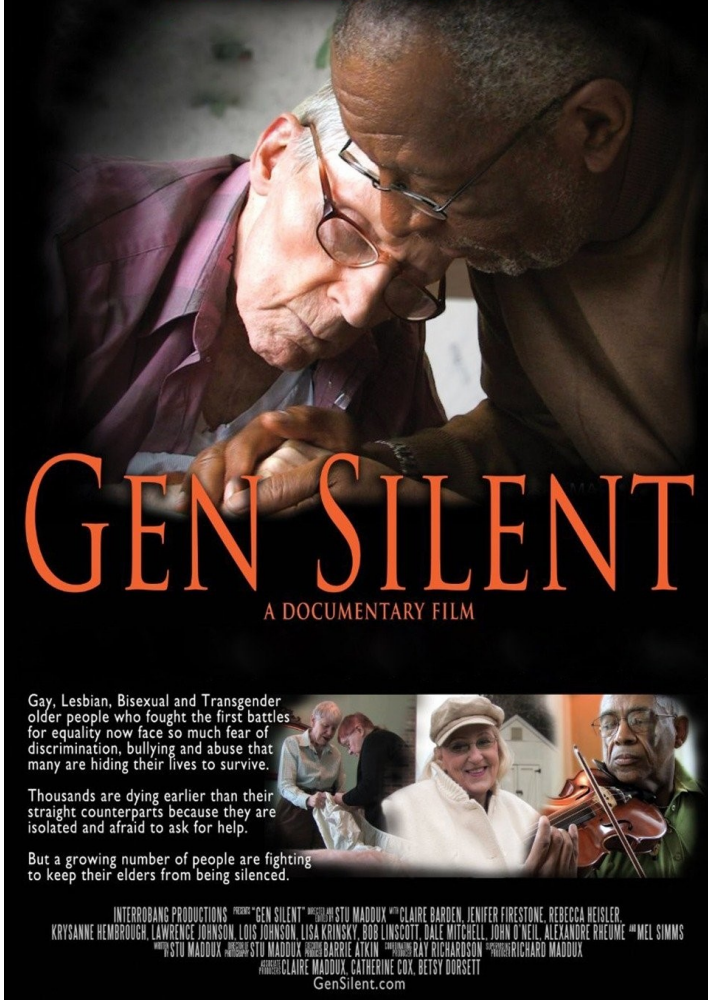


THE GENERATION THAT FOUGHT HARDEST TO COME OUT
